JEREMY KONDRAT
CONDUCTOR

Jeremy Kondrat has served as conductor of the Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra Wind Symphony since 2019. He has conducted the Imperial Brass large brass ensemble since 2011, frequently conducts the Dallas Winds brass fanfares and serves as a guest conductor for the Dallas Winds. Kondrat was named conductor of the McKinney Community Band in February 2016. He is

an adjunct professor at Southern Methodist University where he has taught the Jazz Techniques course since 2016.

Kondrat currently serves as the Coordinator of Instrumental Music in the Plano Independent School District and previously served fourteen years as the Director of Bands, Co-Conductor of the Symphony Orchestra and Director of the Jazz Ensemble at Plano Senior High School. Under his direction the Plano Senior High School Wind Ensemble was awarded the National Wind Band Honor Award in 2009. He has co-conducted the Plano SHS Symphony Orchestra

at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in 2007, 2009, 2012, 2014 and at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in 2003. The Plano SHS Jazz Ensemble directed by Kondrat was invited to perform at Lincoln Center at the Essentially Ellington Jazz Band Festival and Competition in 2005 and 2010. He was also the Associate Director of Bands at Plano Senior High School during the 1998-2000 school year. Prior to joining the team at Plano Senior High School, he served one year positions as Director of Bands at McKinney High School and Associate Director of Bands at Cudahy High School in Cudahy, Wisconsin.

Kondrat received a Bachelor of Music degree in music education and trombone performance from the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York. He earned a Master of Music degree in trombone performance from the University of Northern Colorado in Greeley, Colorado. He has served as a substitute trombonist with the Dallas Wind Symphony and is a freelance conductor and trombonist in the classical and jazz idioms. He resides in Plano, Texas, with his wife, April, and their three wonderful children Emily, Rachel and Ethan.
