



PART-TIME AUDIO TECHNICIAN

The Dallas Symphony Orchestra seeks a technical generalist to support the daily operations of the Audio Visual Specialist at the Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center. This individual will provide technical and production support with a heavy emphasis on theatrical sound and production for arts and cultural events. This individual will also provide support for the lighting technicians as needed.

The Audio Technician will learn, operate and assist in maintaining the performance hall audio systems and equipment as well as the hall and lobby lighting systems; provide technical support for rental events; aid in the execution of load-in and strike for rental events; and perform other duties as assigned.

The ideal candidate will hold a degree in technical theater operations or related electronic technology. This position requires knowledge of audio and lighting equipment and engineering; familiarity with theater practices, equipment, rigging, and facilities and the requirements for a hall acoustically designed for live symphonic music; ability to work at heights up to 80 feet and lift 50 pounds. Also required is the ability to work various hours, including holidays, weekends and evenings. This is a part-time position and will work a maximum of 29 hours per week.
