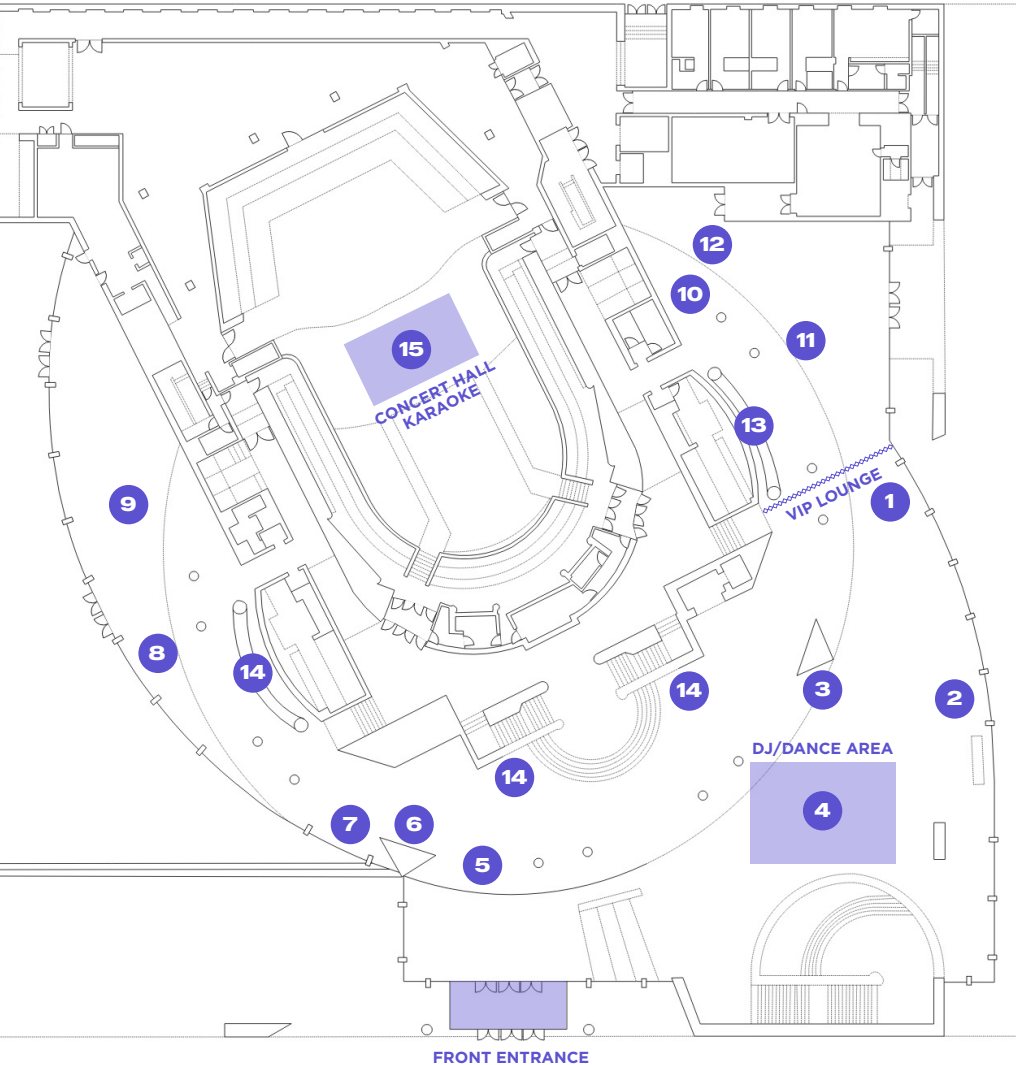

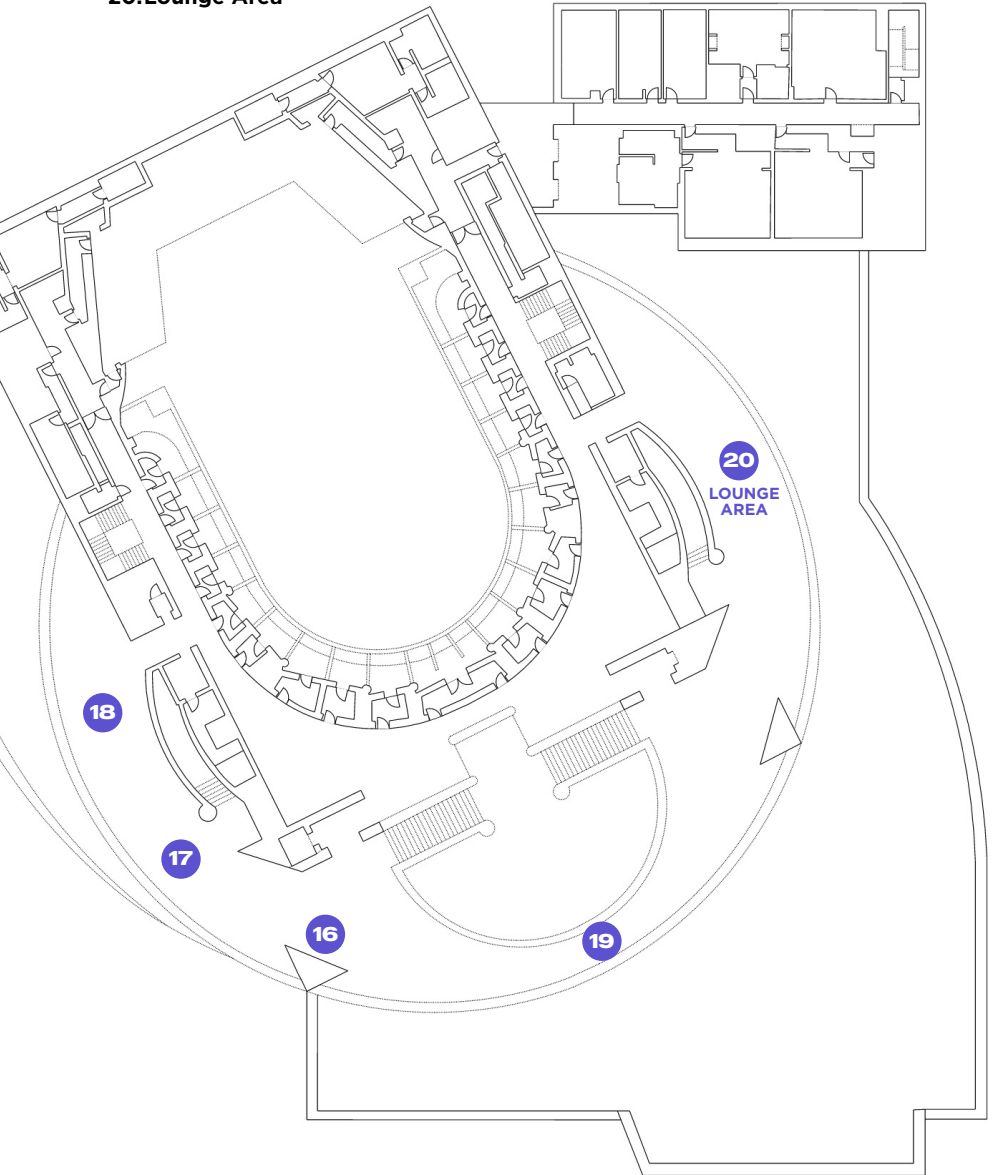

Enrico Lopez-Yañez is the newly appointed Principal Conductor of Dallas Symphony Presents (Nancy A. Nasher & David J. Haemisegger Chair). He was also recently named Principal Pops Conductor of the Pacific Symphony. In addition, Lopez-Yañez serves as the Principal Pops Conductor of the Nashville Symphony. Lopez-Yañez is quickly establishing himself as one of the nation's leading conductors of popular music and becoming known for his unique style of audience engagement. Also an active composer/arranger, Lopez-Yañez has been commissioned to write for the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra, Houston Symphony, San Diego Symphony and Omaha Symphony, and has had his works performed by orchestras including the Baltimore Symphony, Detroit Symphony, Indianapolis Symphony, National Symphony, Seattle Symphony, and Utah Symphony among others.

This season, Lopez-Yañez will collaborate around the country with artists including Ben Rector, Cody Fry, Trisha Yearwood, Tituss Burgess, Jefferson Starship, Portugal. The Man, Aida Cuevas and Lila Downs. Lopez-Yañez will appear with the Detroit Symphony, Colorado Symphony as well as make return appearances with the National Symphony, Philadelphia Orchestra, San Diego Symphony and more. Previously, Lopez-Yañez has appeared with orchestras throughout North America including the Cincinnati Symphony, Indianapolis Symphony, Pittsburgh Symphony, and the Seattle Symphony among others.

As Artistic Director and Co-Founder of Symphonica Productions, LLC, Lopez-Yañez curates and leads programs designed to cultivate new audiences. Symphonica manages a wide breadth of Pops and Family/Education productions that “breathe new, exuberant life into classical programming for kids and families” (*Nashville Parent Magazine*).

TROUPE VERTIGO



Fusing together elements of cirque acrobatics, classical dance and contemporary theater, Troupe Vertigo brings audiences on a spellbinding journey through the world of artistic movement. Consisting of world-class aerial artists, contortionists and ballet dancers, the Los Angeles based company was founded in 2009 by Artistic Director Aloysia Gavre and Technical Director Rex Camphuis. Troupe Vertigo, whose “dizzying acts defy gravity and leave its lucky audiences in awe” (*Los Angeles Times*) has performed with major orchestras across North America.

Troupe Vertigo’s recent seasons have brought them to Baltimore, Detroit, Dallas, Fort Worth, Indianapolis, Pittsburgh, San Diego, Oregon, Tucson, Utah, Seattle, Phoenix, Symphony Orchestras, the Florida and Minnesota Orchestras in the US and Vancouver, Winnipeg, Regina Symphony Orchestras, Calgary Philharmonic and the National Arts Centre Orchestra in Canada. Notable conductors that Troupe Vertigo has performed with include Jack Everly, Jeff Tyzik, Enrico Lopez-Yañez, Stuart Chafetz, Michelle Merrill, Sarah Hicks, Daniel Meyer, Nicholas Hersh and Norman Huynh.

Troupe Vertigo’s facility is also home to Cirque School Los Angeles, which inspires an appreciation for the circus arts for “Anybody with Any Body.” Cirque School uses training, performance and community outreach to foster passion for the circus arts in a supportive, non-competitive environment.
